

RUTGERS INTERCAMPUS TRANSIT SYSTEM **CHANGES IN SERVICE - FALL 2009 SEMESTER**

1. The Labor Education bus stop on the Cook/Douglass campuses has been eliminated due to safety concerns. Passengers can now catch the F and the EE buses at the Henderson Stop at the corner of Ryders Lane and Labor Center Way.
2. Since the Livingston Student Center bus loop has been reopened, the REXL bus will no longer service the Quads bus stop on the Livingston Campus.
3. Due to the completion of the Route 18 project, the F bus route will no longer serve the Civic Square Building on Livingston Avenue. The F bus is now the express version of the EE bus and will no longer make any stops in the downtown New Brunswick area. It will be traveling to and from College Avenue using Route 18. The EE Bus is now the only route servicing all stops in the downtown New Brunswick area (Zimmerli Art Museum, New Brunswick Train Station, Paterson Street, Liberty Street, Rockoff Hall and Public Safety).
4. The New BrunsQuick Shuttle will directly service the new College of Nursing Building in downtown New Brunswick.
5. Campus buses will now only be making ONE STOP instead of two at Cedar Lane Apartments along Cedar Lane on the way to Livingston and only ONE STOP instead of two at Treetop Apartments along Cedar Lane on the way back to College Avenue. The stops closest to Road One on the Livingston Campus have been removed.
6. The Lot 48 bus stop on the Busch Campus will now be known as the "Visitor Center" bus stop and will only be served by the A route.
7. The EE route will no longer stop in front of Scott Hall and Brower Commons. The EE route will now go in the same direction as the other routes on College Avenue. It will stop in front of the College Avenue Gym and Lot 8.
8. The EE, H, and L routes will now continue running on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. Specifically from 4 AM until 7 AM (Thursdays)/8 AM (Fridays & Saturdays), and the New BrunsQuick Shuttle route from 4 AM until 6 AM on Thursdays & Fridays. Shuttles will depart every 30 minutes from their regular stops on College Avenue.
9. The Knight Mover is still available on Sunday through Wednesday nights. Since regular bus service will be operating on the other nights, there is no need for Knight Mover on those nights.
